

## HAHA Guidelines and Reminders

1. All homeowners are **required** to be dues paying members of HAHA.
2. All homeowners are expected to be members of the Heatherwood Area Security Association.
3. No chain link/cyclone fence should be clearly visible from the street.
4. No satellite dish should be clearly visible from the street.
5. No garage should be enclosed (after 9-1-03) without construction of another garage or carport.
6. Motor homes and boats should not be kept at a residence for more than 7 consecutive days.
7. Yards and home exteriors must be maintained by the homeowner. Failure to do so may result in the homeowner's association or City doing so and billing the homeowner.
8. Exterior colors and home alterations should be traditional in nature and compatible with the existing character of the neighborhood.
9. Off-street parking should be available for all vehicles kept at a residence for more than 7 consecutive days.
10. Vehicles should not be parked in front or side yards per City of Jackson code. You may report this infraction at Jackson311.
11. No storage or utility buildings should be clearly visible from the street.
12. No temporary structure may be erected and visible from the street. The exception being a child's playhouse located in the back yard.
13. Garage sales are strongly discouraged.
14. No mailboxes should be placed at the street.
15. Roofs should **not** be metal or of a color such as red, white or green that is not in keeping with the existing character of the neighborhood.
16. Please be a good neighbor and clean up after your pets.
